## I, NORMA BUREAU ELIAS, declare: 1 2 1. I am a patient-member of the Oakland Cannabis Buyers' Cooperative. I have personal knowledge of the facts stated herein and am of sound mind. If called as a witness, I 3 could and would testify competently to such matters. 4 5 2. I am 76 years old. I have five children, nine grandchildren, and one greatgrandchild. I am the retired Deputy City Clerk of San Bruno, California. I was diagnosed with glaucoma when I was 52 years old. Glaucoma can cause 7 3. blindness. I tried every medicine my doctors prescribed for glaucoma, but the medicines never 8 succeeded in keeping down my intraocular pressure. Those medicines also caused me horrible side effects: extreme nausea, rapid heart beat, and insomnia. By 1995 my eyesight was 10 11 deteriorating badly when I read about medical cannabis myself. 12 4. Cannabis holds the pressure in my eyes down, without any side effects. I use cannabis with calamus root powder three times per day. Now my doctors are amazed at how 13 good my optic nerve looks. They tell me my optic nerve looks as good as if I did not have 14 15 glaucoma. If I could no longer obtain cannabis from a medical cannabis dispensary, I do not 16 5. know how I would obtain my medicine. I might go blind. I am 76 years old and would never use 17 marijuana recreationally. I only obtain cannabis from medical cannabis dispensaries. I do not 18 know how I would go about buying marijuana illegally. A drug dealer might go to prison for 19 selling it to me. If I did obtain cannabis that way, I would have no way of knowing whether or 20 21 not it was cannabis of acceptable quality.
